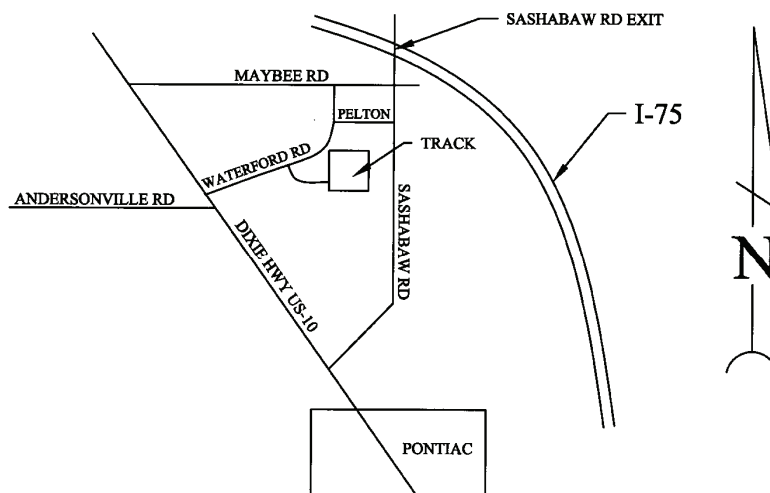

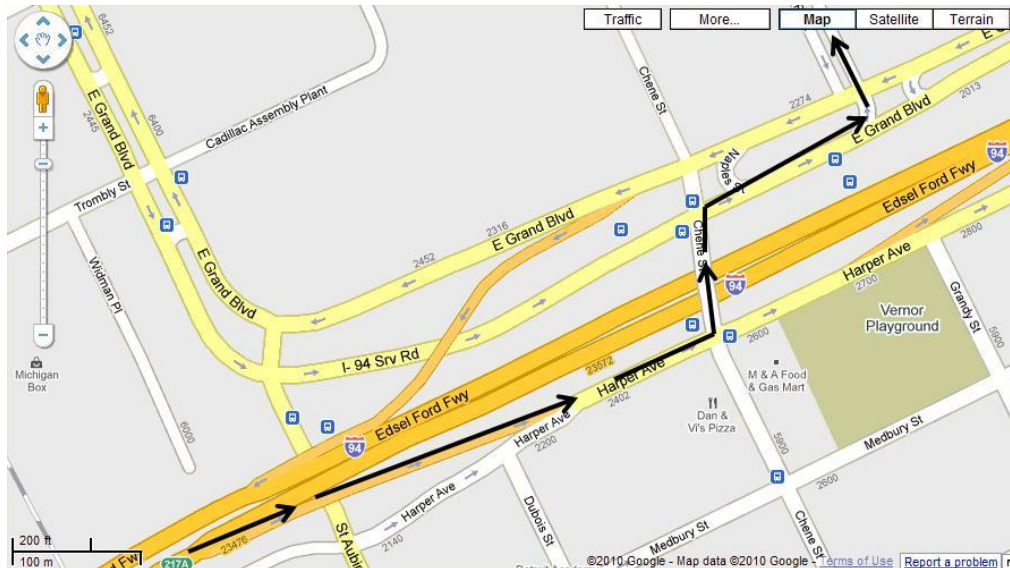

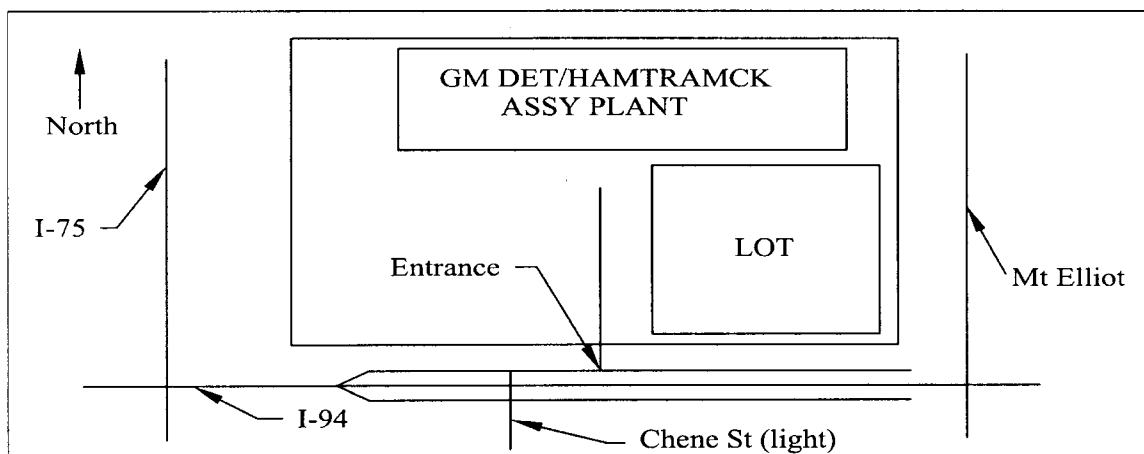

Zora Arkus-Duntov was hired by Ed Cole one month before the first 1953 Corvette was built. Zora's "job" was to turn the Corvette into America's Sports Car. When Zora retired 22 years later as the first Corvette Chief Engineer, he had done far more than just his job!
