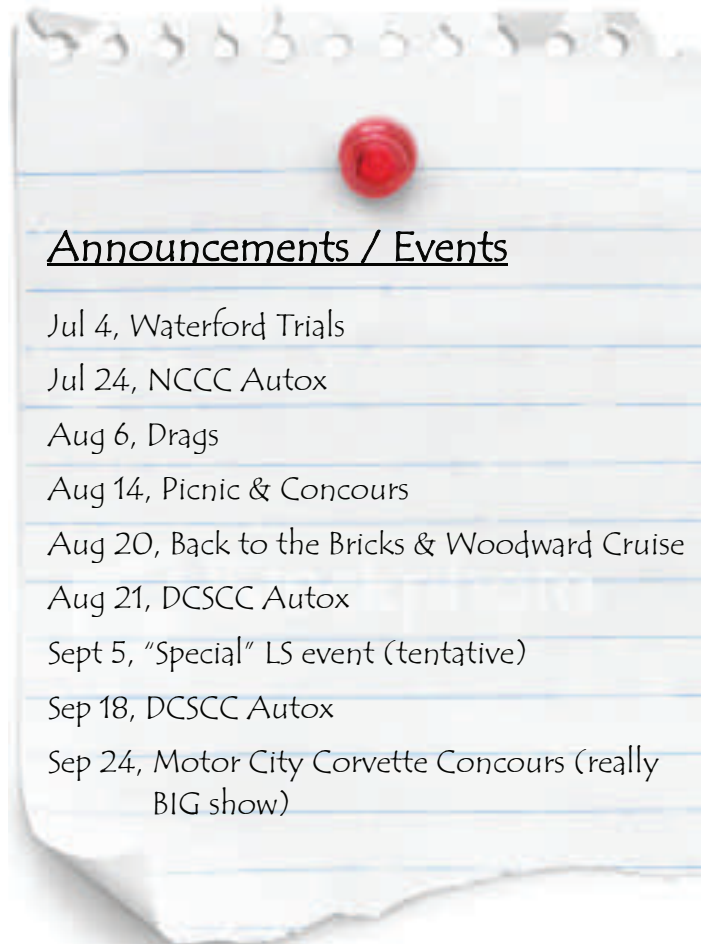


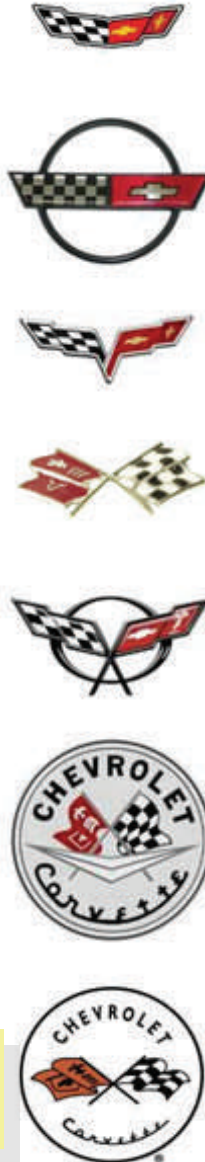

NCCC Convention 2011
