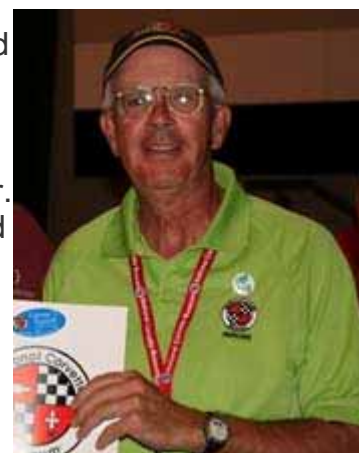

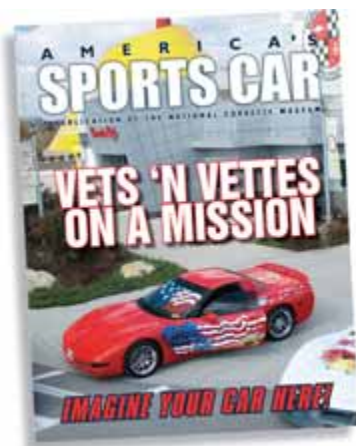


Vets 'n Vettes a Month Away!

It may be getting cooler outside, but it's not time to put those Corvettes away yet. October is a very busy month, and we still have four points-scoring events to go between now and the first weekend of November.

First up on October 8th, we'll be having 5 NCCC-sanctioned rallies co-chaired by Bruce and Mary Wentzel. This promises to be a fun day with the start of the rallies at Baker's of Milford and the finish at Danny Kellermeyer's shop in Ortonville.

Next, on October 9th, we have 5 NCCC-sanctioned low speed events at the Poletown Plant. This autocross will be chaired by Chris MacKay and Paul Yuska. Chris and Paul have planned for the course to be setup on the West side of the plant, connecting the smaller lots together once again. Lunch will be provided.

Also on October 9th, we will be dedicating the event to the memory of Barb Bush who passed away earlier this summer after a long battle with pancreatic cancer. DCSCC Report

DCSCC Report

By the time you have a chance to read this, there will be just one Champ Series autocross event left for the 2011 season. This is an event that'll be hosted by our club, on October 23rd, at our traditional site . . . the Hamtramck assembly plant. Come on out for a last chance to pilot your car through an autocross course, or just come hang out with fellow club members (and perhaps work on the course for a bit).

One item that I'd like to highlight. The Detroit Council Championship Series is unique in that it offers a team competition. There are several clubs that are members of Detroit Council. Some clubs take the team championship very seriously.

CCM is fortunate to have talented drivers within their ranks. With two events to go, CCM has one of their teams in third place and another team in fourth place.

In third place is "CCM White". This team is composed to Chris Scafero, Chris MacKay, Brandon Lincoln, Ted Godett, and Bill Rietow. With very limited participation by Ted and Bill this year, Chris, Chris, and Brandon have done a great job to put this team in third place.

Chasing "CCM White" for the third and final trophy position is "CCM Red". Mary Wentzel, David Orton, Fred King, Bruce Wentzel, and Rhonda Kralemann are the members of this team.

How does the team competition work? Each team is composed of five drivers. At each event, the top three scores from each driver are added together to give the team score. Then each team is ranked against the others, with the lowest ranked team earning one point and each team above earning an additional point.

The driver's score is based upon their individual score for the event. That is determined by their overall time, as calculated from an index. What the index does is allows all drivers to compete against each other, with a higher index value (multiplier of 1.0) assigned to the fastest class and a lower multiplier assigned to slower classes.

Okay, that concludes the math discussion for this month.

As we head into the winter months, there will be discussions for revisions to the rule book and a call for officers. Several of the Council officers have served for many years and will be looking for a break. If you have an interest in how a sanctioning body works, this may be a chance to become involved. Ask me how; I've done most of the roles within Detroit Council, and I may come "shoulder tap" you to help out.
