Thank you for your interest in the Corvette Club of Michigan. Please let us extend an invitation to attend one of our meetings so you can see the Club in operation. Membership meetings are held the **fourth** Wednesday of each month (except in December) in the service bay of Les Stanford Chevrolet, 21711 Michigan Avenue, Dearborn. The meeting begins at 8:00pm and consists of a business meeting, swap and sell, and a program pertaining to Corvettes. Coffee and donuts are served.

CCM was founded in 1958 by a group of Corvette enthusiasts who shared a common desire to have fun in their Corvettes. Throughout the years, our membership has grown to several hundred participants from all walks of life. We have families with children, couples, and singles that all enjoy CCM activities. Our goal is to bring together Corvette owners to enjoy each other's company as well as their common bond: *the Corvette*.

Requirements for CCM membership include being at least 18 years of age for master membership, a valid driver's license, and proof of Corvette ownership (or lease). In joining CCM, you will also become a member of the National Council of Corvette Clubs. Your spouse and/or children are welcome to join as associate members at a reduced rate. Please see the attached sheet for membership fees.

As a Corvette Club of Michigan member, you will receive a copy of our monthly newsletter, the SlipStream, which provides information on all activities. You'll also receive a 25% discount on Corvette parts purchased from our sponsor, Les Stanford Chevrolet. Each year we publish a competition handbook and a directory of CCM members, both of which are available only to our members. Throughout the year we host both social and competition activities. Listed below is a brief description of some of the events we offer:

Socials: Social gatherings include an annual family picnic, cruises, an annual awards banquet, caravans, and pool or bowling parties. Our social committee is always looking for suggestions for activities our members would enjoy.

Drivers School: This annual school introduces new members and novice drivers to the competition season. It consists of two parts: a classroom session and a driving session. Attendees learn about the elements of different types of events, tech inspections, and safety tips for competitive driving.

Autocross: This is a time-based competition that tests your driving skills through a mini road course of pylons. The course is usually set up in a parking lot, and participants are timed separately driving through the course.

- Rallye:** This is a competition event on paved roads where you follow a prescribed route at a defined speed to a finish point. You pass through checkpoints along the way and calculate your time, speed and distance.
- Concours:** This is a show where your Corvette is judged for cleanliness and condition.
- Drags:** This event involves drag racing other Corvettes in your class at a sanctioned drag strip. Even if you're not going to participate, it's a fun outing to go to just to watch.
- Time Trials:** This is a competition on a closed course such as Waterford Hills Road Racing Course, where you can test your driving skills at greater than freeway speeds.

As you can see from this list, we have a wide variety of activities. As a member, you can participate in the events and socials that are of specific interest to you.
